COURSE INFORMATION: Drug Endangered Children (DEC) are those children who suffer physical, sexual or emotional harm or neglect resulting from exposure to an environment where adults are manufacturing, selling or using drugs. Exposure to these highly toxic substances and chemicals can cause serious short and long term health problems. Many times, the living conditions in these homes are deplorable. In response to this growing epidemic, counties throughout California and the nation are developing coordinated responses to remove these children from dangerous environments. The Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Program joins forces with law enforcement, social services and the district attorney's office to investigate and prosecute these violators. Curriculum will include the identification of DEC children, protocols, MOU's, investigative methods, prosecution techniques, how each discipline can assist the other in rescuing children from drug environments, child abuse laws and Cal EMA grant requirements.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Law enforcement administrators/officers/detectives, social workers, prosecutors, code enforcement, fire/hazmat, medical and mental health professionals, probation/parole and other first responders.
