SEARCH AND SEIZURE & SEARCH WARRANT UPDATE

Instructor: Tia Quick has been a DDA for 18 years, and the law enforcement liaison at SDPD for the past 5 years. She has been in the JUDGE unit, GANG unit, and the Superior Court unit during her time as a DDA. She is an instructor for the POST ICI Foundation & Advanced Gang Investigation Course. For the past four and one half years the focus of her job as the liaison has been the reviewing of search warrants, updating officers on the law, and helping maintain a positive relationship between police agencies and the DA's office.

Description: This course will explain the importance of writing search warrants and the surrounding issues, such as, when it is appropriate to seal a warrant or parts thereof, rules for sealing a warrant, use of telephonic warrants, and essential basics of what is needed for a solid warrant that will withstand judicial review. Additionally, as each portion of the warrant writing process is discussed, new rules from the courts will also be discussed along with new cases in the areas of inventory searches, Gang Association Warrants, Qualified Immunity for law enforcement on warrants, searching cell phones, and a review of search and seizure since the decision rendered in Arizona v. Gant. **There will also be an update on the new laws on tracking devices and changes in search warrant law. BRING A THUMBDRIVE IF YOU DESIRE COPIES OF INFORMATION FROM THE INSTRUCTOR.**
