COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Focus is on problem solving and use of information obtained as a result of the surveillance. Specific tactics, strategies and problem solving models will be addressed during the course.

Unmarked cars are needed to make this class successful. There will be a practical exercise, and the unmarked police cars will be utilized.

INSTRUCTOR:

Detective **Rick Ellington**, 30 year veteran of the San Diego Sheriff's Department with 22 years as a Narcotics Investigator and currently assigned to the San Diego DEA Narcotic Task Force. Rick's Surveillance Class has been sought out by law enforcement agencies throughout the county. Rick also teaches Surveillance Techniques at the 2 week DEA Basic Investigators School.
